

## **Create Your Own List**

Recommended Items:
$\square$ A 3-day supply of non-perishable food & 3 gallons of water per person
☐ A map with at least 2 evacuation routes
☐ Necessary prescriptions or medications
☐ A change of clothes & extra eyeglasses/contact lenses
☐ Extra car keys, credit cards, cash, medical cards
☐ A first aid kit & sanitation supplies
☐ A flashlight & battery-powered radio with extra batteries
☐ Copies of important documents (birth certificates, passports, etc.)
☐ Cell phones with all necessary contact numbers, & chargers
☐ Pet food & water
Always have sturdy shoes and a flashlight near your bed, ready for sudden night evacuations.

## **Recommended List for Pets**

☐ Carrier/Crate (one per pet)		
☐ Collar and tags		
☐ 2 leashes/harnesses per pet		
☐ Water and water bowl/container		
☐ Food in waterproof container		
☐ Medicine in marked sealed clear plastic bag		
☐ Copies of rabies, registration, microchip (waterproof bag)		
☐ Pictures of pet and adults (waterproof bag)		
☐ Emergency foil blanket (cover crate, warmth)		
☐ Poop bags, litter, paper towels		
☐ Muzzle (if needed)		
☐ Toys/blanket for comfort
